

1. Please define the following "bars" found in Internet Explorer: Address bar, Command bar, Menu bar, Scroll bar, Status bar, and Title bar.

<u>Address bar:</u> Contains the URL or address of the active Web page; also, where you type the location for the Web page you want to visit.

<u>Command bar</u>: A horizontal toolbar located on the right side of the window; provides a selection of options used to execute common commands.

Menu bar: Lists menu commands if you select the option to display the menu bar.

<u>Scroll bar</u>: Lets you scroll vertically or horizontally if the Web page is too long or too wide to fit within one screen.

Status bar:Located at the bottom of the browser; shows the progress of Web page transactions.

<u>Title bar</u>: The bar on top of the window that contains the name of the document.
